

**BARTLETT SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE**

To the Inhabitants of the School District of Bartlett, in the County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote on District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Josiah Bartlett Elementary School gymnasium in said District on Tuesday, March 7, 2017 at 6:30 in the evening to act upon the following subjects:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$7,576,955 for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for school district officials and agents, and for the payment of statutory obligations of the District. This article does not include appropriations voted in other warrant articles. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 2: To see if the School District will vote to approve the cost item included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Bartlett School Board and the Bartlett Education Association which calls for the following increases in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

<u>Year</u>	<u>Estimated Increase</u>
2017-18	\$62,966
2018-19	\$59,668


and further to raise and appropriate the sum of \$62,966 for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels under the existing collective bargaining agreement. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 3: To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$14,000 to initiate the next phase of the Technology Program as recommended by the Technology Committee. (Designated as a Special Article) (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)



ARTICLE 5: To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.


