

JACKSON SCHOOL DISTRICT WARRANT
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

To the Inhabitants of the School District of Jackson, in the County of Carroll, State of New Hampshire, qualified to vote on District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Whitney Center in said District on Thursday, March 2, 2017 at 7:00 in the evening to act upon the following subjects:

ARTICLE 1. To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$2,568,116 for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for school district officials and agents, and for the payment of the statutory obligations of the District. This article does not include appropriations voted in other warrant articles. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 2. To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to be added to the Capital Reserve Fund (School Buses) previously established for this purpose. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 3. To see if the school district will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) to be added to the Whitney Maintenance Trust Fund previously established for this purpose in 2010. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 4. To see if the School District will vote to approve the three-year tuition contract with the Bartlett School District for the Jackson seventh and eighth grade students to attend the Josiah Bartlett Elementary School. (Majority vote required) (Recommended by the School Board 5-0-0)

ARTICLE 5. To transact any other business that may legally come before this meeting.






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
