

Guide for Parents*

This publication provides general information about the operation of the Title I program in the Bartlett School District. Please keep it available as a reference throughout the school year. We hope it will make your access to the school personnel and their services more convenient.

Overview

Title I of the federal Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) funds programs whose purpose is to help students improve their basic skills by supporting and reinforcing classroom instruction. This support is provided to students in a small group setting.

JBES has a Title I reading program. This program supplements regular classroom instruction. Students generally meet with an instructor 3-4 times a week for half-hour periods.

Student Identification

Students are identified for the targeted assisted program based on available information from all or some of the following sources:

- ◆ present classroom teachers
- ◆ previous teachers
- ◆ formal assessments
- ◆ referral from parents

Parent Notification

Annual Title I informational parent meetings are held at each school in the fall usually during Open House Night. Other meetings can be arranged as requested by Title I parents.

Title I Parent Involvement Policy

All Title I programs have a policy for how they will involve parents. This policy explains how the school will support the important role of parents in their child's education. We look forward to working with you. A copy of this policy is sent home or made available to every Title I parent. A parent compact is sent home to all Title I parents as well.

The compact lists specific responsibilities of school staff, parents, and students. Compacts are in place at all schools.

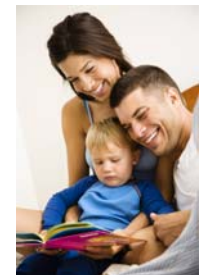
Conferences

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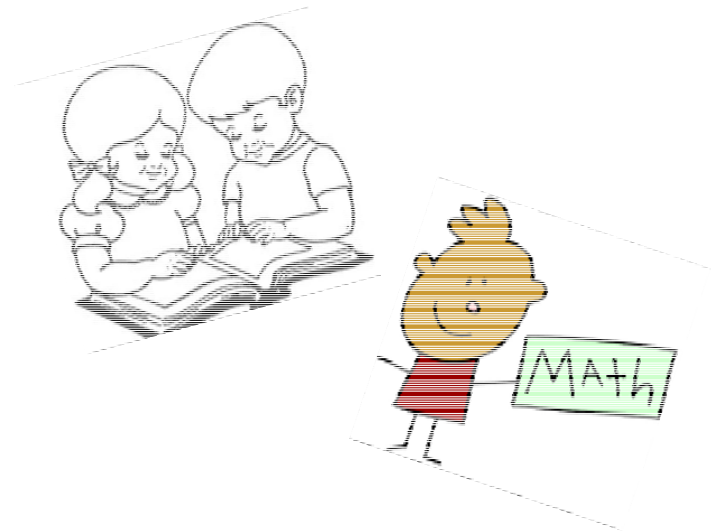
