





Please read the message below (from the SAU) about eclipse plans and dismissal changes on April 8th.

Dear SAU 9 students, families and staff members,

On Monday April 8, 2024 there will be a solar eclipse in New Hampshire during the approximate hours of 2:10 p.m.- 4:30 p.m.

The town of Conway will observe the eclipse at about 98% obscurity. This is a significant educational opportunity for our students and staff to experience a lifetime event.

It is expected that the eclipse will bring many visitors to northern New Hampshire, Maine, and Vermont. The tourist impact may impede traffic to the north and to a lesser extent the Mount Washington Valley. There is also concern for traveling during the peak eclipse viewing time frame.

Staff have been preparing for this event to help students experience the eclipse in a safe manner. Each school has approved eclipse glasses for each student to view the eclipse safely.

NO ONE should view the eclipse without proper eyewear!

All schools in SAU 9 will have a modified end of the day schedule on April 8, 2024 due to the eclipse occurring during the typical dismissal times. Standard bus departure will NOT take place at the regular time and we will be offering the following alternative schedule.

Conway Elementary Schools (PTS, JFS, CES)

• Elementary students may be picked up early by parents/guardians at or before 1:45 p.m. for students choosing not to stay for the eclipse. Please dismiss students through the main office.

OR

• Elementary students may stay at their school under the supervision of staff until 4:30 p.m. For students choosing to stay, there will be bus transportation provided at the close of the eclipse period or students can be picked up by parents at 4:30 p.m.

There will not be Project SUCCEED programming on April 8th.


